They were delighted to hear about the brewery, which dates back to 1795 and stands on the River Nene and is owned by the 5th generation of the Elgood family.

Huntingdonshire Branch committee member, Peter Martin, said: "We were very well received by the Elgood's staff and enjoyed some of their excellent beers before enjoying a

tour of the brewery." Members were shown the workings of a traditional family brewery run by Nigel Elgood and his wife, together with their three daughters.

Following the tour, Elgood's provided a buffet at which members enjoyed a networking opportunity along with samples of the wide range of Elgood's beers including their 'QE' range, which stands for 'Quintessentially English', one of which was apple and vanilla.

Peter continued: "The tour proved

very educational, being taken through the traditional brewing methods as well as viewing the original vessels used in the brewing process. During the tour we were joined by the 'company cat' whose role in such an old building needs no explanation.
